Next week sees some of our Y6 children starting their transition days at secondary school. We wish them the best of luck!



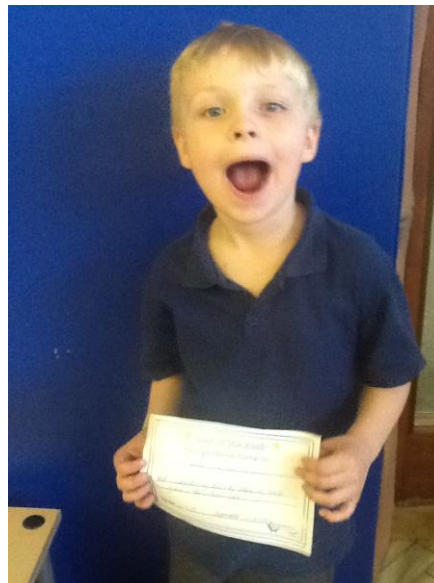

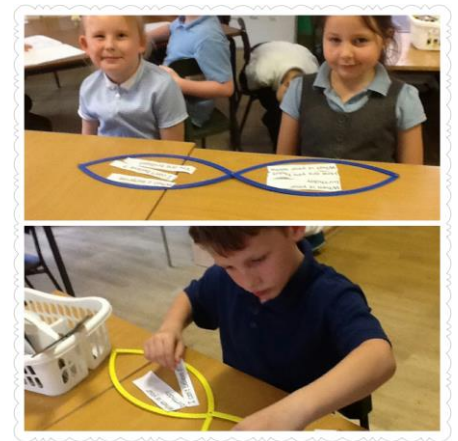

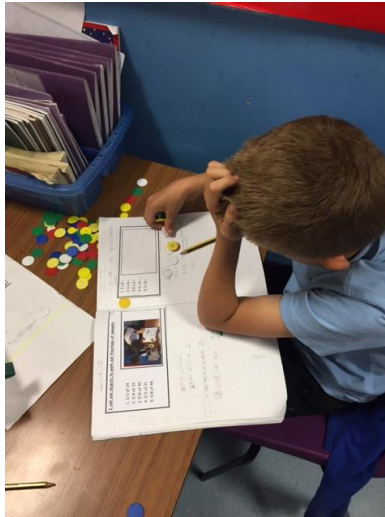
