Being in the right place, at the right time, doing the right thing!


The reward scheme allows children to earn points for showing 'Green Behaviour' which may consist of trying hard in their work, being courteous and polite (possibly holding a door open), showing respect to others, arriving at school in time for registration and having the correct uniform.

When children earn 10 green Frog points they will get a reward from the treasure box.



Writing

We use Talk for Writing to teach literacy in the Foundation Stage. This is a multi sensory approach to reading and writing and gives children a deeper knowledge of the focus text.



Maths

We have daily Maths sessions. Children will be focusing on the following areas over this half term: counting, writing, ordering and comparing numbers to 10. addition and subtraction

Foundation 1 will be focusing on Shape and Space, whilst Foundation 2 will be looking at addition.


